Fun run:

- Jim is planning on sending a Peach Jar every few days to remind parents of the Fun Run.
- Point of clarification: Donations will be accepted up until the day of the Fun Run.
- Checks should be made out to "Franklin PTG."
- Money will be kept in the safe. Kim may pick it up in two trips for deposit.
- One objective for fundraising is for picnic tables for the blacktop and field. They'll be 8-foot tables and ADA compliant.
- Additional funds will go towards supplemental after school ASL classes.
- PTG needs to figure out how we want to hand out water bottles and sunglasses. Immediately after the Fun Run? In the classroom? Recess? Every student will receive either one, but we need to figure out how to distribute them with disrupting class.
- Field condition seems ok for now. Hopefully the weather holds up. If it doesn't, we could move the route to the blacktop.
- Set up will begin at 1, kids will start showing up at 1:30.
- We need to get colored wrist bands (similar to those worn at a fair or concert). Hopefully enough for each grade. If not, we can use index cards like cross country.
